Students with a 3.00 G.P.A. or higher may enroll in more than 9 hours for Summer or 19 hours for Fall/Spring without seeking additional permission. In no case shall the maximum number of hours exceed 12 hours for a regular Summer semester and 6 hours for Summer intersession, and 24 hours for a regular Fall/Spring semester. This is a combined number of hours from NSU, including correspondence and arranged classes, and any other college or university that the student attends during the semester.

<u>NEW STUDENTS</u> should submit an application and credentials at least one month prior to enrollment. For details, contact the Admissions Office, CASE Bldg.

ENROLLMENT SERVICES will assist transfers and undeclared majors with the enrollment process. All new students will be notified of enrollment procedures.

READMISSION OF FORMER STUDENTS - Students who have attended NSU, but did not enroll in the immediate past semester (summer sessions are not included), must be readmitted. Students who have enrolled in another college since attending NSU must submit official transcripts of all work attempted before readmission can be granted. For details, contact the Admissions Office, CASE Bldg.

<u>GRADUATE-STUDENTS</u> should submit an application and credentials one month prior to enrollment. Students not enrolled the previous spring or fall semester must be readmitted. For details, contact the Graduate College, A 122, Admin. Bldg.

ACADEMIC YEAR HOUSING CLEARANCE - If you are single, under 21, have completed less than 60 hours, live outside a reasonable commuting distance (approx. 45 mile radius) from Tahlequah and plan to live off campus (includes commuting or seeking approved off campus housing) you must clear Housing (Leoser Center) before enrolling.

VETERANS - All persons receiving VA benefits must report to the Veteran Education Office (CASE Bldg.) upon completion of enrollment.

ACADEMICALLY INELIGIBLE TO RE-ENROLL - If you enroll early, and become ineligible to continue, your registration will be canceled. After one or more semesters following suspension, you may petition the Admissions, Enrollment and Retention committee for readmission. The student should submit an application for admission, a letter of appeal and official transfer transcripts to the Admissions Office by October 15 for spring semester, April 15 for summer semester and July 15 for fall semester.

TO CANCEL ENROLLMENT - If you cannot attend NSU after you enroll, it will be necessary to withdraw prior to the beginning of classes by contacting the Office of Admissions and Records.

DEGREE PLANS - Degree plans will remain in effect provided the student has had continuous enrollment. Students who have been out three semesters must file a new degree plan and will be subject to any new degree requirements.

ACADEMIC FORGIVENESS POLICIES - Students may

repeat up to four classes (not to exceed 18 hours) of "D" or "F" grades and have only the last grade earned used in the calculation of the retention and graduation GPA. In certain circumstances, students may apply for an academic reprieve for up to two consecutive semesters of course work or academic renewal for removal of all previous coursework. For more information regarding the Academic Forgiveness Policy, contact your advisor or the Office of Admissions and Records.

<u>CLASS SCHEDULE CHANGES</u> - Changes in schedule during the add/drop period will result in full charges for courses added and full refund for courses dropped. Refunds will not be made after the defined add/drop period.

COLLECTION COSTS - Unpaid accounts receivable may be assigned for collection. If an account is assigned, any collection costs, court costs, and/or attorney's fees necessary to collect the amount owed will be added to the balance due. The balance due may be reported to national credit bureaus, which may adversely affect credit ratings. A hold will be placed on university records and future enrollment until the balance is paid in full.

GRADUATION CHECKS -Graduate Students who expect to complete requirements for master's degrees next term should submit a degree check form to the Graduate College, Room 122, Admin. Bldg. Forms to request the Degree Check are located on the Graduate College home page. Degree check requests are not taken during grade reporting, registration or add/drop periods.

<u>GRADUATING?</u>- Each student who expects to complete degree requirements must file an application for bachelor's or master's degree in the Office of Admissions/Graduate Office by March 1 for Summer graduates, May 1 for Fall graduates, and October 1 for Spring graduates. The bachelor's application must be turned in with a copy of the official degree plan.

<u>COMMENCEMENT</u> - Commencement ceremonies are held in May and December of each year. Students who have completed degree requirements in May or anticipate completing requirements by August, may participate in the May commencement. Students who complete degree requirements in the Fall may participate in the December commencement.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY - Students are personally responsible for completing all requirements established for their degrees by the university, college and department. A student's advisor may not assume these responsibilities and may not substitute, waive, or exempt the student from any established requirement or academic standard.

<u>UNIVERSITY</u> NOTICE- Please register early. Courses are subject to cancellation due to low enrollment. All information is subject to change. New sections of courses can be found on the open class list on the NSU home page (www.nsuok.edu).

ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

Access to **NSU EXCELS** automated telephone enrollment service is based on the number of hours you have completed when you enroll. The **NSU EXCELS** schedule and more detailed instructions for using the service are in the center section of this Class Schedule. You may OPT in for the Talon charge account during your enrollment.

During each of the scheduled **NSU EXCELS** enrollment periods, the service begins at 9:00 a.m. on the first day and is available each day through midnight the last day. Unscheduled maintenance may also temporarily interrupt service.

Students who enroll in a class or classes and <u>never</u> attend may be administratively withdrawn (AW) from the course or courses. The administrative withdrawal (AW) could be done from the third week through the tenth week of 16 week classes. Classes on other formats (8 week, 4 week, etc.) will be based on the same percentages of completion for the time frame an administrative withdrawal can be processed.

Students who are administratively withdrawn will be responsible for payment and repaying any financial aid received for the course(s) that must be returned to the provider.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

TUITION AND FEES ARE DUE

All fees are due by January 7, 2011. If payment is not paid by February 7, 2011, late fees will be assessed and a hold will be placed on any future enrollment and on your academic records. The late fee for tuition and fees is \$20 the first month and \$10 for each month thereafter. Also, a \$20 late fee will be assessed for late payment of housing charges. Talon charges must be paid in full by the 15th of the following month to avoid a late fee.

STUDENTS WITH FINANCIAL AID

If you have financial aid, it may be used to pay your tuition and fees. At the end of the add/drop period, your financial aid will be applied directly to your outstanding tuition, fees, book charges, housing, etc. Any excess fund will be distributed through the NSU Green Card

NSU disburses all refunds to students electronically. Students are mailed a debit card called the NSU Green Card. <u>Please do not throw this card away</u>. The numbers from this card are used by the student to activate their information with a banking services company named Higher One. As a part of this activation, the student will indicate whether they wish to open a free checking account with Higher One or if they prefer to have any refunds routed directly to an existing checking or savings account. May 30.....Memorial Day Holiday

June 2.....Last Date to Drop a Single Class or Withdraw from All Intersession Classes

NOTE: A grade of "W" can be assigned in classes dropped between May 31 and June 3 only if the student has a passing grade at the time the class is dropped.

June 3.....Intersession Classes End

Classes taken during the May intersession will appear on the transcript under the Summer 2011 semester. A student may enroll in a maximum of six (6) hours during the intersession and total regular enrollment for Summer 2011 and the intersession must not exceed eighteen (18) hours. Students on full time financial aid must enroll in at least six (6) hours for Summer 2011. Courses taken during the intersession will count toward partially meeting the credit hour requirements for financial aid but the money will not be credited to accounts until after regular summer school begins in June. If a student enrolls in the intersession, they will not receive financial aid and then only completes courses in the intersession, they will not receive financial aid and will be individually responsible for paying the bill.

Enrollment Period for Intersession

TAHLEQUAH

The enrollment period will be March 28 through May 10 by EXCELS. No REFUNDS will be allowed after May 10 (the second day of class for classes meeting the entire three weeks). For classes meeting less than the three weeks, no enrollment or refunds will be allowed after the first class meeting.



The NSU EXCELS registration service allows you to register for special permission classes pending approval of the appropriate dean. The service will instruct you when to call back and confirm that permission has been granted. If the dean does not grant you permission to enroll, the class will be removed from your schedule. Any questions about special permission classes should be referred to the appropriate dean.

Closed Classes

The **NSU EXCELS** registration service will not permit you to register in a closed class. If your class selection is closed, **NSU EXCELS** will provide information about all the other closed sections of that class. You may wish to mark these closed classes in your class schedule booklet before making another selection.

The course instructor, your academic advisor and Admissions Office personnel cannot give permission to register you in a closed class. You must see the dean, or use **NSU EXCELS** to add your name to the waiting list.
