## Resources for Grant Funding Opportunities

### Current Funding Announcements and Deadlines

There are many federal agencies and private foundations that are potential funders for a grant project. Although certainly not exhaustive, the following list is a good place to start. The most common and often utilized funding resources are listed below:

#### Grants.gov

[www.grants.gov](http://www.grants.gov)

Grants.gov is a source to find and apply for federal grants. All federal agency grant opportunities are listed, making grants.gov a good place to begin searching for a grant to apply for. American Recovery Reinvestment Act (ARRA or "Stimulus" Funds) opportunities are listed on grants.gov.

#### Community of Science (COS)

COS is the world's most comprehensive funding resource for **all disciplines, not just the sciences**, with more than 25,000 records worth over \$33 billion. Funding agencies include private foundations, public agencies, national and local governments, corporations and more. You must use this service from a Northeastern State University computer or be logged into your COS account remotely.

#### National Science Foundation (NSF)

NSF is the funding source for approximately 20 percent of all federally supported basic research conducted by America's colleges and universities. In many fields such as mathematics, computer science and the social sciences, NSF is the major source of federal backing.

#### National Endowment for the Arts (NEA)

The NEA is a public agency dedicated to supporting excellence in the arts, both new and established; bringing the arts to all Americans; and providing leadership in arts education. NEA is the nation's largest annual funder of the arts.

#### National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH)

The NEH is an independent federal agency that provides grants for high-quality humanities projects. NEH grants



typically go to cultural institutions, such as museums, archives, libraries, colleges, universities, public television, and radio stations, and to individual scholars.
