FORMS FOR NSU MEDIA DAY:

CONTEST RULES

BEST ALL-AROUND NEWSPAPER

Entrants must submit **THREE** newspapers published between **Sept. 1** and **March 1** of the **2011--2012** school year. A Best All-Around Award will be selected from each category entered. This category is judged separately from all individual categories.

BEST ALL-AROUND YEARBOOK

Entrants must submit their 2010-2011 yearbook.

WRITING COMPETITION ON MEDIA DAY

Entrants will write sports and news stories during the morning session on Media Day. Each school may enter **ONE PERSON** in each competition.

OUTSTANDING ADVISER/OUTSTANDING ADVISEE

Each school can nominate its adviser and one student. Nominations should be no longer than two pages, double-spaced and should be included with the school's entries. Winners will be announced during the Awards Ceremony.

SCHOOL/INDIVIDUAL WRITING COMPETITION

Each entrant must submit at least two, no more than three stories, photographs, cartoons or examples of layout from each of the categories. An entry form must be stapled to each entry.

All newspaper entries must have been published between **Sept. 1** and **March 1** of the **2011-2012** school year. Yearbook entries can come from last year or the current school year. Many schools change staffs and want their current yearbook judged in competition.

Stories, cartoons and photographs are to be affixed to standard size typing paper with an entry form stapled to the front of each individual entry. (Remember each individual entry needs to contain at least two examples of the student's work).
