C.H. Parker, now-retired Northeastern State University instructor of speech and theater, and the late Joe Davis, NSU jazz studies director, created the script for the River City Players' first production, *Ferlin's Folly* or *Dolly Goes to Dixie*. Combining the best of popular music, Broadway hits, gospel, and everything in between, River City Players quickly became one of the most popular shows produced by NSU. Now in its 29th season, River City continues to showcase the vocal talents of the university's students while featuring the musical styling of the institution's faculty.
