The NSU Model United Nations Program faculty advisor, Assistant Professor of Political Science Dr. Ron Becker remarked that “this is a truly a great achievement for our program. Northeastern State University has left its mark on the Big Apple. This is our first trip to the National Conference, and given the relative youth of our delegation, the award is much unexpected.”
