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P-20 Council Objectives

The P-20 Council will take lead action on these work plan objectives:

- 1. Increase public awareness and understanding of the challenges facing human investment efforts, especially education, and what really needs to happen to promote greater success
- 2. Increase accessibility to higher education for all students including concurrent enrollment and dual enrollment programs.
- 3. Organize a community wide "math and science renaissance" initiative to enhance math, science and overall technology skills at all levels of education. Focus is on increasing high school graduates without the need for remediation in science and math, and increasing higher education enrollment in the areas of science, technology, engineering and mathematics.



 Develop a strategic plan for preventing disengagement of teens and young adults from school, work, and general steps for individual improvement articles.

Other designated partners will take lead action on these work plan objectives; the Council will monitor progress.

- 1. Increase resources for Community Schools and Conexiones to support expansion of current effort, as well as extension of community schools into Middle Schools.
- 2. Develop 2-3 year strategy for creation of an effective birth through 3rd grade system (School of 21st Century Plus with "First School" Approach) that promotes both quality early childhood development and strong supports for working parents
- 3. Increase understanding of student mobility and its impact on student and school success as related to movement through the human development pipeline

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
